

Funding- overview of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) in Jordan

This leaflet shall give you an overview about the different scholarship programmes available for Jordanians. However, make sure to also read the detailed information on each scholarship programme listed below on: www.funding-guide.de.

Master scholarship programmes

1. Development-Related Postgraduate Master Courses (EPOS)

This scholarship programmes offers 36 Master programmes which are offered at several German universities. The portfolio includes mainly programmes in the **fields of economic sciences, development cooperation, engineering, regional planning, agricultural and forest sciences, environmental sciences, medicine/public health and social and political sciences**. Applications have to be directed to the respective university and not to the DAAD. Application deadlines differ from programme to programme but **most deadlines are between September and October**. 2. Helmut- Schmidt- Programme (Master`s Scholarship for Public Policy and Good Governance- PPGG)

This scholarship programme offers eight different study programmes within the fields of politics, law, economics and administration according to the principles of Good Governance. Applications have to be directed to the respective university and not to DAAD. A list of participating universities as well as comprehensive information can be found on www.daad.de/ppgg. **The application period at all 8 universities lasts from 1st June to 31st July.**

3. Study Scholarships for Foreign Graduates in the Artistic Fields

DAAD offers four Master scholarship programmes for foreign graduates from the artistic fields of **Architecture, Performing Arts, Music and Fine Art/ Design/ Visual Communication and Filmin** order to complete a **postgraduate degree** leading to a final qualification or a **complementary course** that does not lead to a final qualification (not an undergraduate course). Applicants have to apply for the scholarship to DAAD first and then later seek for admission at the universities of their choice. **Deadline for DAAD scholarship is currently the 31st October except for Architecture field is on 30th September.**

4. Sustainable Water Management (Study Scholarships and Research Grants- Master`s Studies in Germany)

Within this scholarship programme students can choose between four Master programmes at four different universities which focus on the thematic fields of water and energy, water and health, water and nutrition, water and environment and water and urban areas. These Master programmes mainly address students from the natural sciences, environmental sciences and fields of engineering. Applicants have to apply for the scholarship to DAAD first and then later seek for admission at the universities of their choice. **Deadline for DAAD scholarship is the 11st December.**

PhD scholarships and research grants

DAAD offers different PhD scholarship programmes and research grants that vary in duration, requirements and specification. The application deadlines differ from programme to programme. More information about the different programmes can be found on the www.funding-guide.de.
