- **a statement of purpose** (max. 2000 characters)
- **and a CV** (max. 5 pages, 10MB)

**by August 10, 2021**

For being eligible, you must **hold a PhD**, have a **very good command of English** (B2/C1) and an **evident link to Germany** as a research destination. The call is open to **all disciplines**.

The **statement of purpose** should address a) your field of research and previous research experience, b) your interest in Germany as a research destination, and c) a prospective research project. The **number of participants** is limited to 20. All applicants will receive a reply (acceptance / rejection) by August 30<sup>th</sup>. The workshop is going to be held by **proWiss Consulting Services for Researchers** in English.
