HOW TO APPLY?

Applications must be handed in via <https://www.daad.de/surveys/399434?lang=en> and include:

- ✓ a **statement of purpose** (max. 2000 characters), and
- ✓ a **CV** (max. 5 pages, 10MB)

by May 15, 2023

For being eligible, you should

- ✓ **hold a PhD** or be close to finishing your dissertation,
- ✓ have a **very good command of English** (B2/C1),
- ✓ have a **link to Germany** as a research destination, and
- ✓ be affiliated to a **Lebanese** university or research institution.

The call is **open to all disciplines**. The **statement of purpose** should address a) your field of research and previous research experience, b) your interest in Germany as a research destination, and c) a prospective research project. The number of participants is limited to 25. All applicants will receive a reply by May 20. Please note that **travel expenses and overnight stays will not** be covered by DAAD.
